# LET'S GO - NEUIGKEITEN AUS DEM GREEN OFFICE



We are the Green Office (or Sustainability Office) of our university and take care of all sustainability issues in research, teaching and operations at HGU. Our eight-member team consists of four permanent employees and six student employees who are passionate about initiating and supporting transformation at our university.

Here you'll find all the latest news from the Green Office and on sustainability at the university.

### **What happened?**

#### **Fairtrade Workshop - Developing new goals for our fair University**

At the end of April, a workshop was held under the leadership of Vanessa Mark, where university members worked together to develop goals for creating a fairer university. The following goals were identified:

**Use of Fair Products in Everyday University Life:** The problem of the lack of student common rooms on campus and the increased use of fair products should be addressed together to improve the quality of life in everyday university life. The aim is to establish a board game café serving fair coffee/tea in a little-used space, such as the AStA meeting room, the modeling hall, or a room in cooperation with the city.

**Events/Public Relations on Fairtrade:** A group has been formed with the project goal of integrating Fairtrade topics into existing events, initially focusing on language courses.

**Fair Products and Their Sale at the University:** There already is fair coffee in the cafeteria and Wanner waffles and we had the 150-year hoodie, but further potential can be exploited, especially in the area of merchandise and for the welcome bags for new students. The latter could, for example, be made from fair cotton and possibly filled with fair products such as chocolate.

Fairtrade activities are managed by a steering committee composed of students as well as staff from research and administration: The workshop aimed to network university members beyond their study programs and competencies for the management of Fairtrade activities. To reflect on past efforts and develop new initiatives, such a workshop should be held once per semester. Additionally, even better infrastructure for exchange should be established.

The speaker, Jörg Höhler, a board member at ESWE-Versorgung in Wiesbaden, will explain which strategies, instruments, and technologies need to be used or developed to enable the transformation of heat generation. It is crucial to involve citizens in this inevitable transformation process. Jörg Höhler will be accompanied by two ESWE employees: Verena Baldassi, Project Manager for Strategic Projects, and Ralf Cohrs, Head of the Planning, Renewable Energies, and Infrastructure Department.

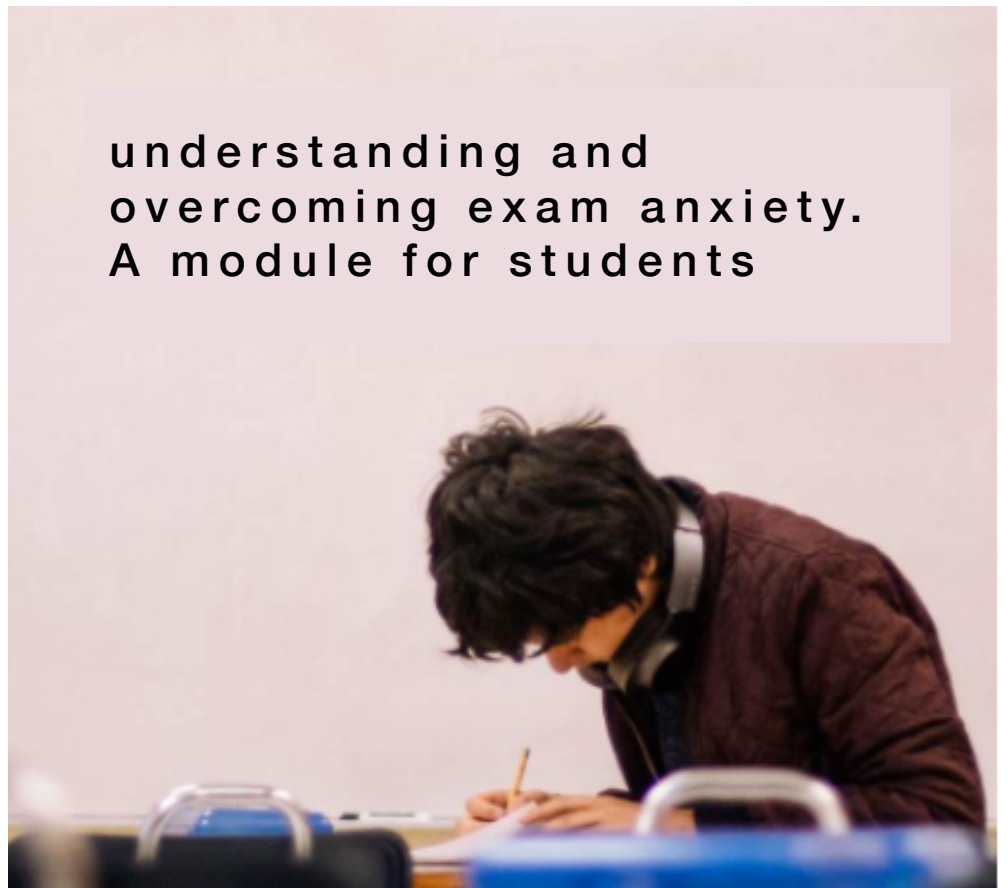


### EXAM NERVES - WHO HASN'T EXPERIENCED THEM?

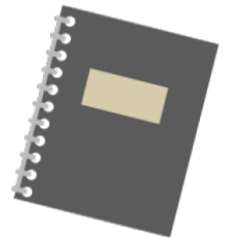
